1. Completed application form
 2. Application fee
 3. All academic documents
 - 10th & 12th Mark Sheets
 - Diplomas / Bachelors / Masters (Provisional, Individual and Consolidated Mark Sheets)
 - IELTS Score Card (6.0 with 6.0 min for SDS Entry)
 - Resume
 - Passport Photocopy
 - Work experience certificate or course certificate (if gap is more than 6 months)
 4. Additional documents for Universities
 - Statement of Purpose (SOP)
 - 3 letter of recommendations (LOR)

VISA

1. Passport Original
2. Visa Application Forms
3. LOA (Letter of acceptance) from Designated Learning Institute DLI
4. Academic Transcripts (Bachelors, Class 10th & 12th)
5. Statement of Purpose
6. College Tuition fee Paid Receipt -**1 Year Tuition Fee**
7. Guaranteed Investment Certificate (GIC) - CAD 10,000
8. Medicals (Approx. Rs. 5,000)
9. NON-SDS : For Universities & General Categories: Loan Letter, Savings, Income Source

NOTE:

- ✓ Visa fee for Online and Drop Box is CAD 235
- ✓ Average Visa time frame under SDS would be 30 business days
- ✓ It is always advisable to drop for visa at least one month ahead of start date of classes
i.e. December 1st for January intake and August 1st for September intake
- ✓ Student willing to apply for Undergraduate course under SDS should have IELTS score of 6.0 with No band less than 6.0
- ✓ For Graduate programs under SDS one should have 6.5 with no band less than 6.0
- ✓ MBA Typically 600 + GMAT is required
- ✓ Universities- Master's Program typically need Strong GPA & Research Background
- ✓ Maximum number of backlogs accepted by MOST Canadian Institutions is 7-8

Student Direct Stream (SDS)

SDS is an arrangement between selected Canadian colleges and Canadian High Commission in India to provide quick and easy study visa for the prospective students. The visa processing is easier and quicker under SDS and you have to show fewer documents.

- ✓ Early Decision for VISA
- ✓ High Chances of VISA
- ✓ No Additional Financial Documents Required
- ✓ Easy for Post-Graduate Work-Permit

General (Non-SDS) – More Funding must be Declared, Family Income & Financial (Loan or Bank Savings with Source of Funds) Documents – Additional Time for Verification



Working On-Campus: (20 Hrs\Week)

- ✓ Full-time students are eligible to work On-Campus.
- ✓ Jobs at any local business inside the campus or the more research/ teacher assistant jobs

Working Off-Campus : Full-time students pursuing an academic, professional or vocational training program at a designated learning institution will be Eligible to work off campus without a work permit : 20 hours per week during a regular academic session and full time during regularly scheduled breaks
